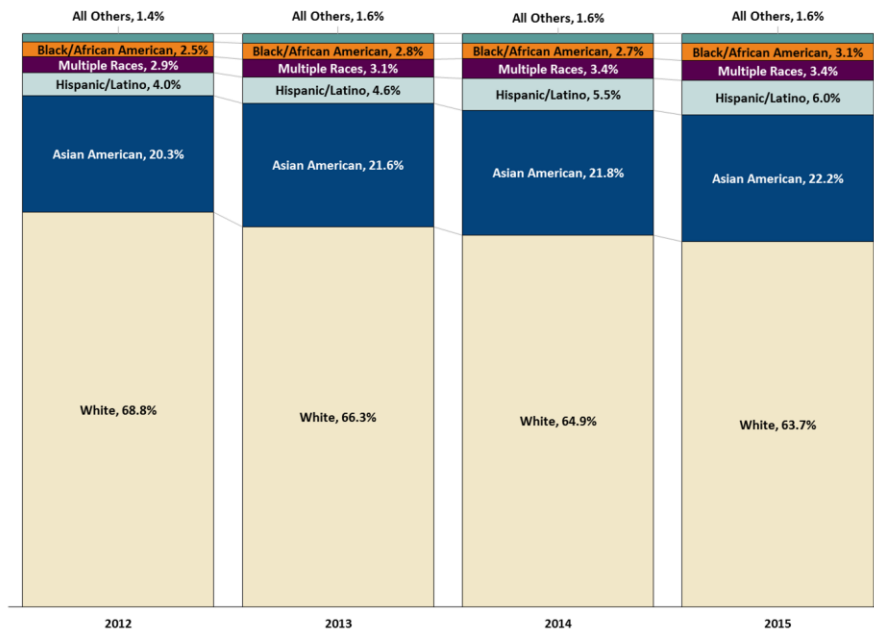

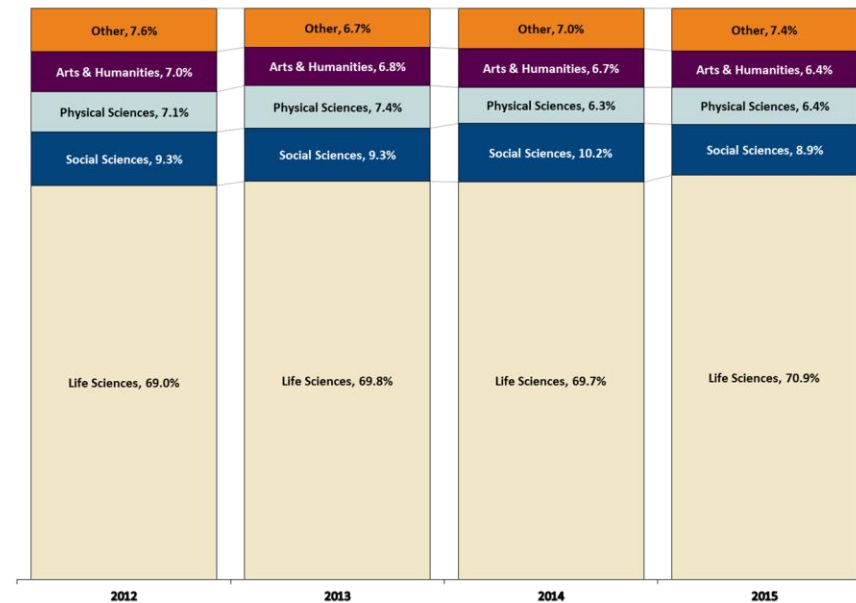

# AACOMAS Matriculant Profile - Entering Classes 2012-2015

A four-year review of the American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS) matriculant pool offers some interesting comparisons over an extended time-frame. Four years is a convenient time-frame for analysis because that is the typical length of undergraduate medical education.

Following are some key elements to note regarding the matriculant pool for entering classes 2012 through 2015.

- **Total Matriculants** – The number of matriculants has grown from 5,574 in 2012 to 6,797 in 2015, an increase of 22 percent over four years.
- **Gender** – For classes entering 2012 through 2015, the percentage of female matriculants was between 43 and 44 percent.
- **Age** – The mean age of matriculants decreased from 25 to 24 in 2015; the median age is 24.
- **Military Experience** – Over four years the percentage of veterans matriculating to the AACOMAS colleges has remained between 1.2 and 1.3 percent. The percentage of serving military personnel has declined slightly by 0.2 percent to 1.0 percent.
- **Race/Ethnicity** – Over the four year period, the percentage of matriculants reporting underrepresented race/ethnicity status has increased from 6.5 percent to 8.9 percent. Underrepresented race/ethnicity status includes Hispanic/Latino ethnicity, Black/African-American, Native American/Alaska Native, and Hawaiian/Pacific Islander race.
- **Undergraduate Major** – The percentage of matriculants majoring in the life sciences has increased since 2012, from 69.0 percent to 70.9 percent. The percentages of matriculants reporting majors in the social sciences, physical sciences, and arts and humanities have remained relatively stable. Most of the change has come with fewer matriculants reporting majors in other disciplines that are not categorized as noted.
- **Grade Point Averages** – Over four years the grade point averages – undergraduate and undergraduate plus graduate and/or post-baccalaureate have increased by about .04 points. Additional breakouts by race/ethnicity and gender are provided.
- **MCAT scores** – Mean total MCAT scores have increased by 0.48 from 26.85 to 27.33 over four years. These increases are reflected in scores broken out by gender and race/ethnicity.
- **State/Country of Residence** – The percentage of matriculants who listed their legal country as the United States declined slightly from 99.2 to 98.8 percent over four years. Canadian matriculants have increased from 37 to 67 and other international matriculants have increased from 5 to 15. Within the cohort of US residents there is minimal change of state of legal residence over four years.

*Note: The University of North Texas Health Sciences Center at Fort Worth/Texas College of Osteopathic Medicine and NYIT-COM's émigré program applicants are not included in this analysis because the data are not part of the AACOMAS database. UNTHSC/TCOM receives its applications through the Texas Medical and Dental School Application Service.*

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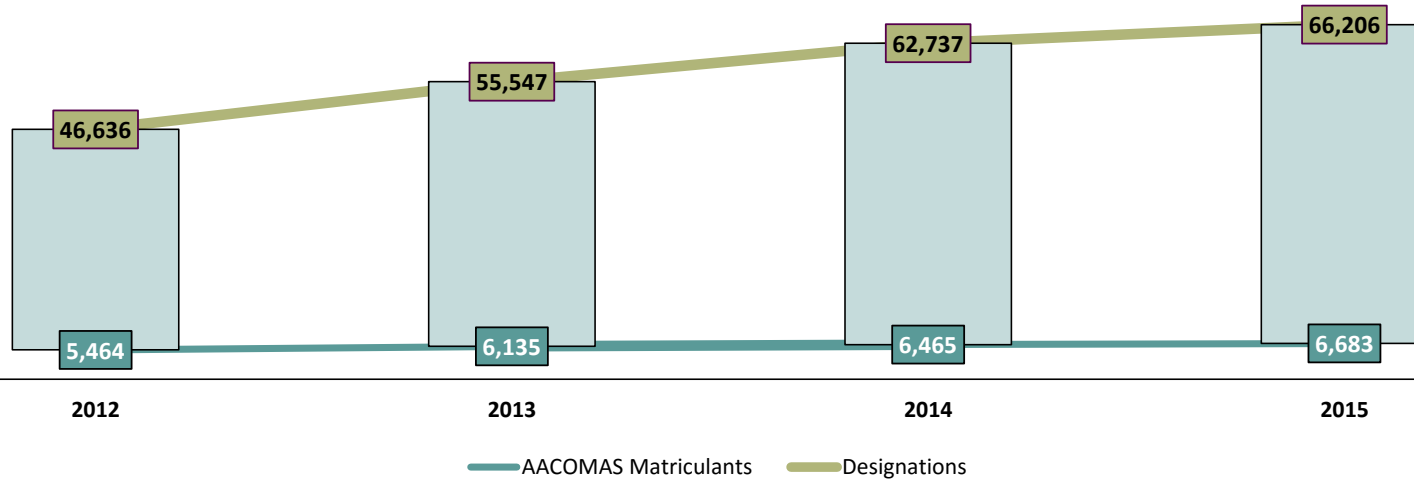

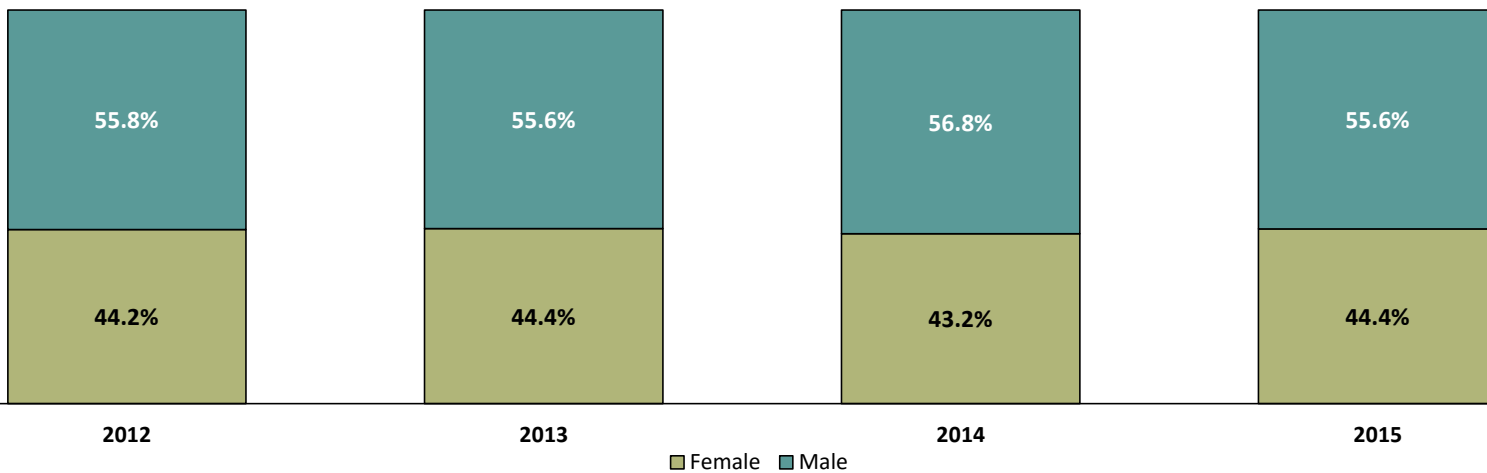

## Matriculants and College Designations - Frequency

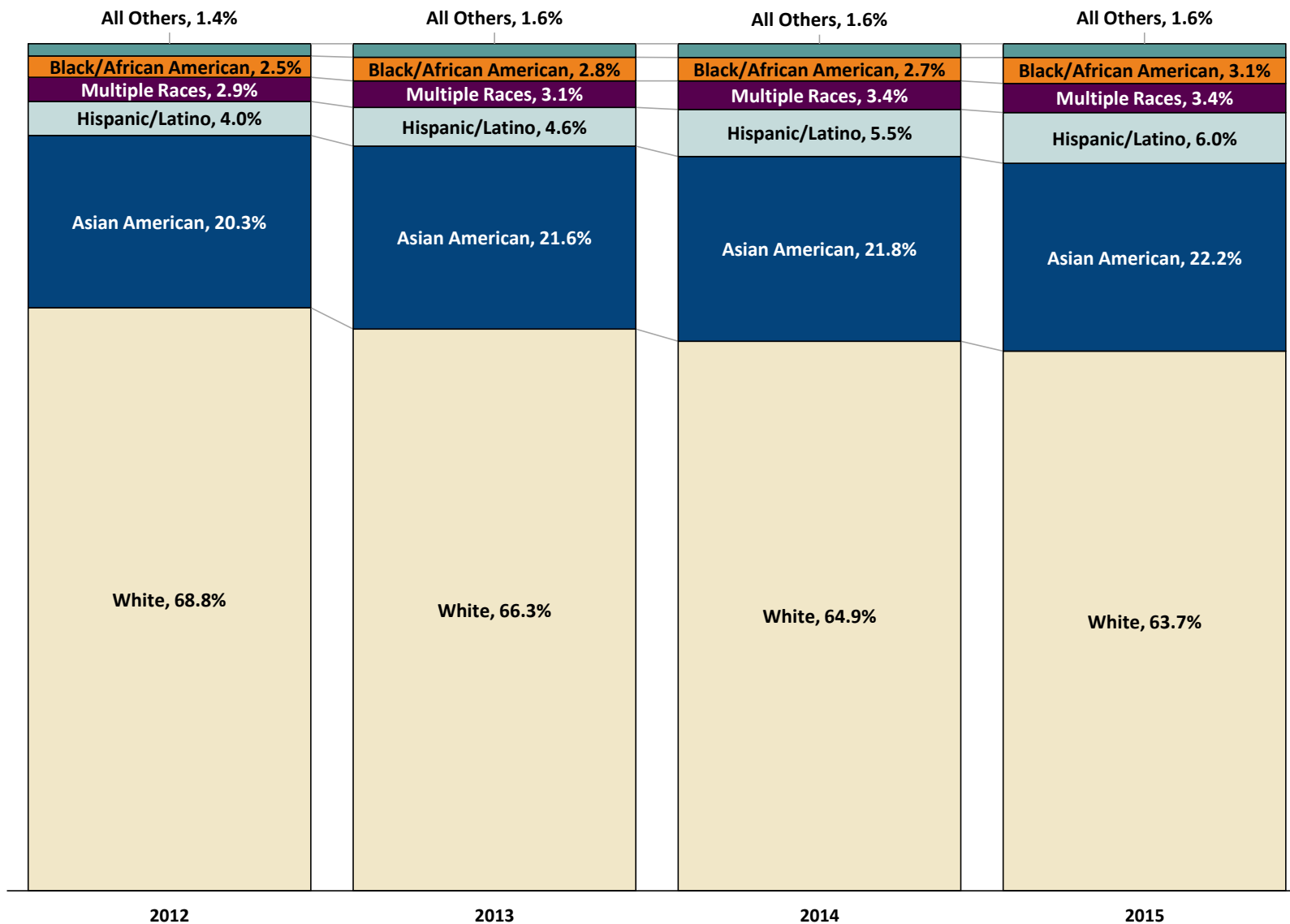


## Matriculants' Gender - Percent

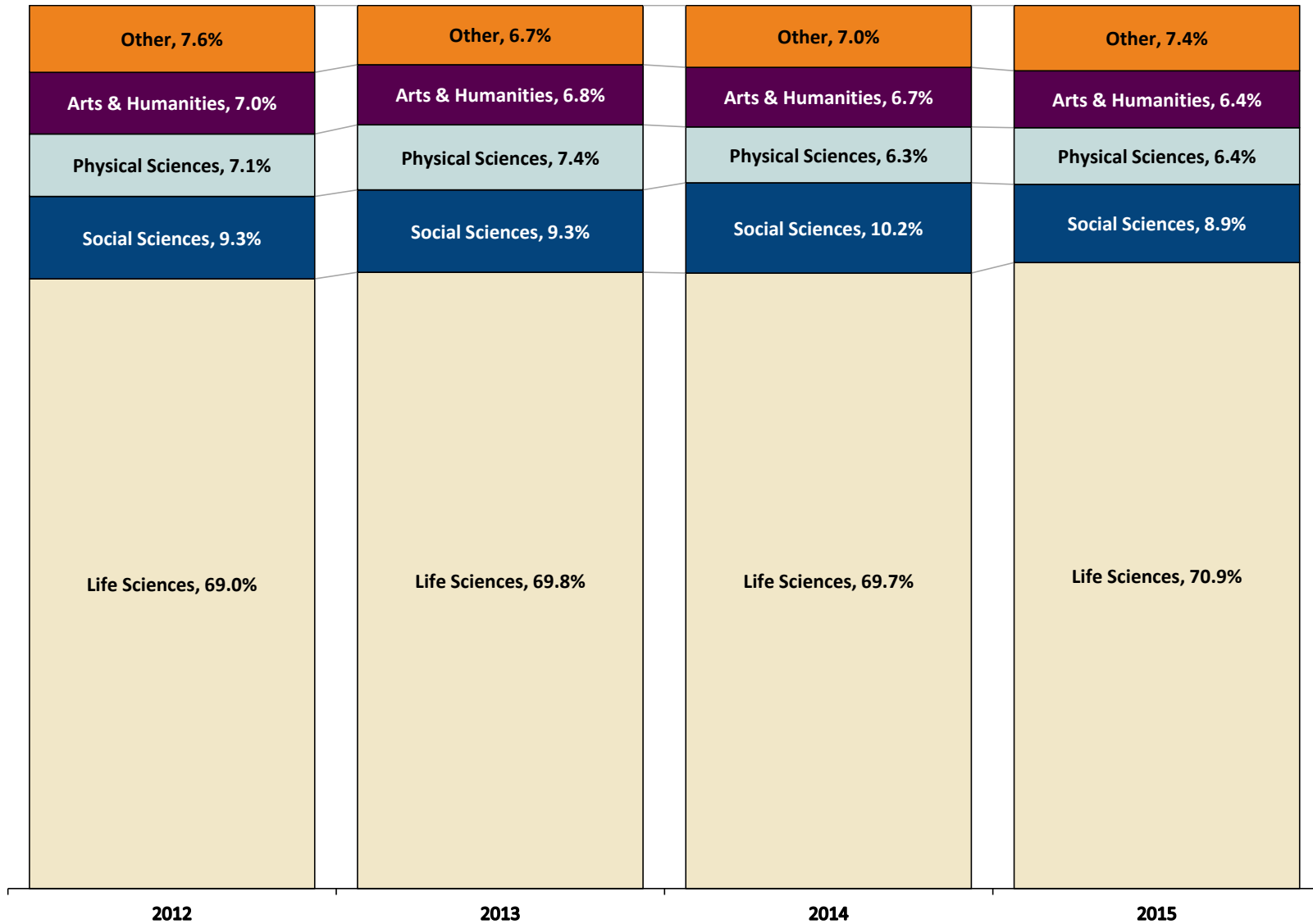
## Matriculants' Single Category Race/Ethnicity - Percent

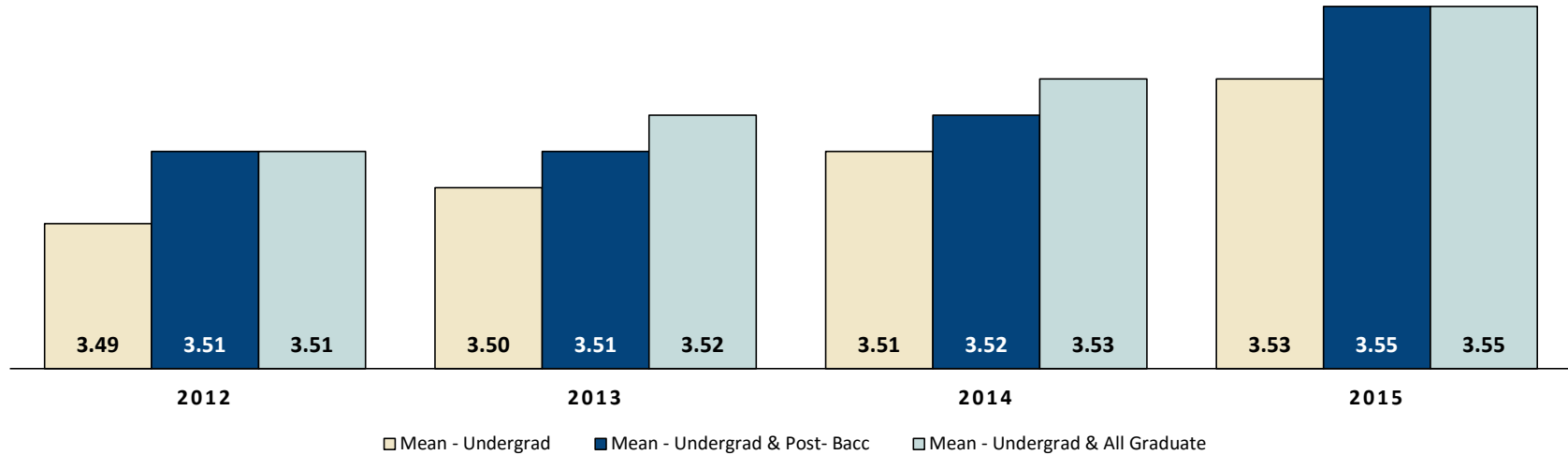

## Matriculants' Baccalaureate Degree Major - Percent

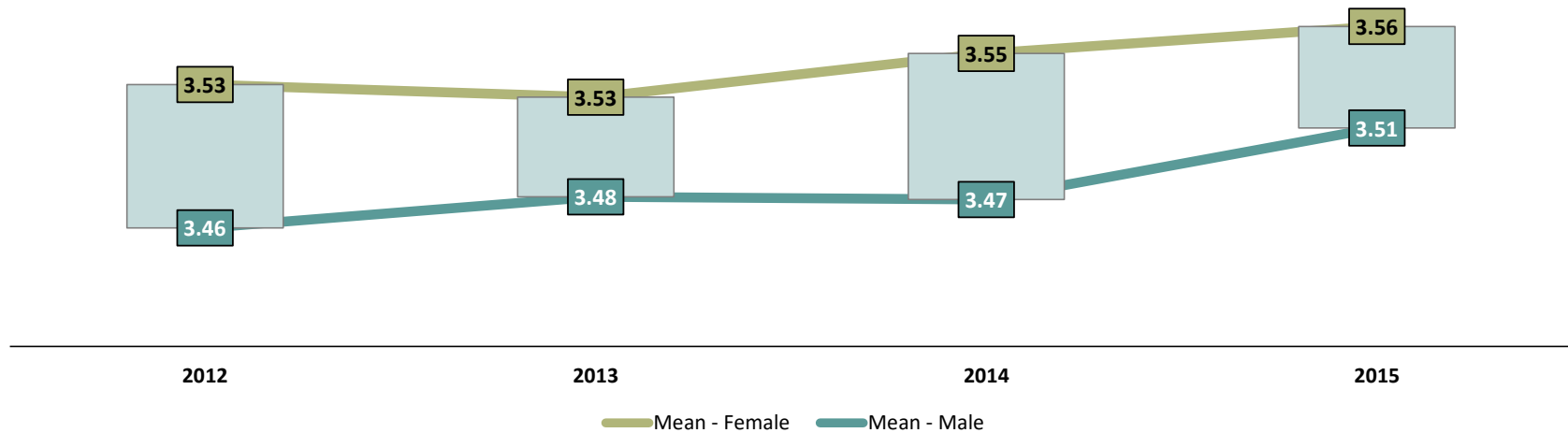

## Matriculants' Overall GPA by Academic Level - Mean

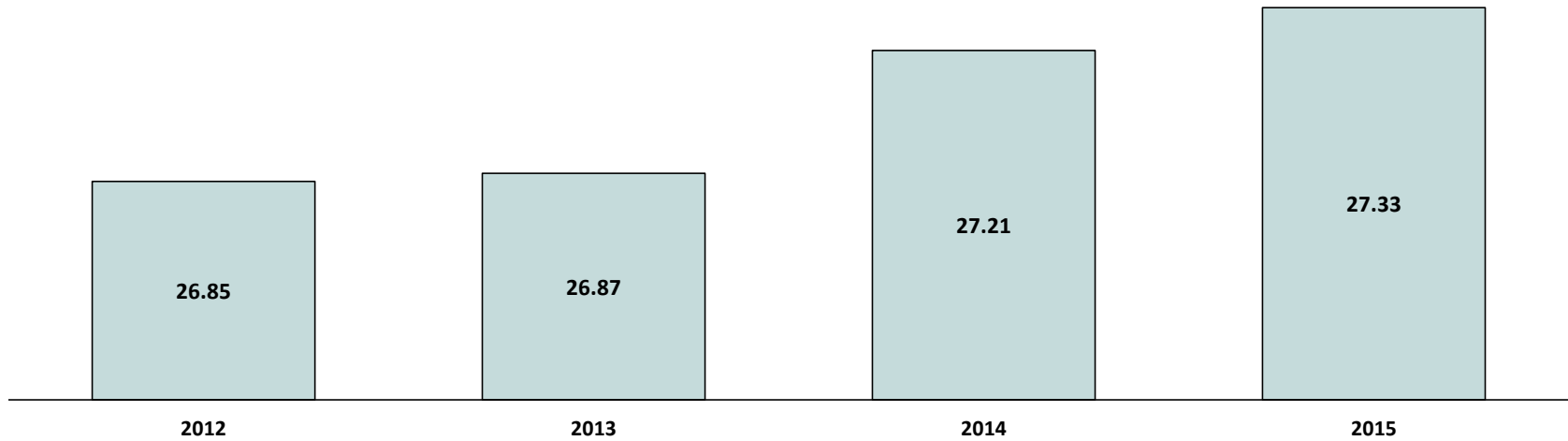


## Matriculants' Undergraduate GPA by Gender - Mean

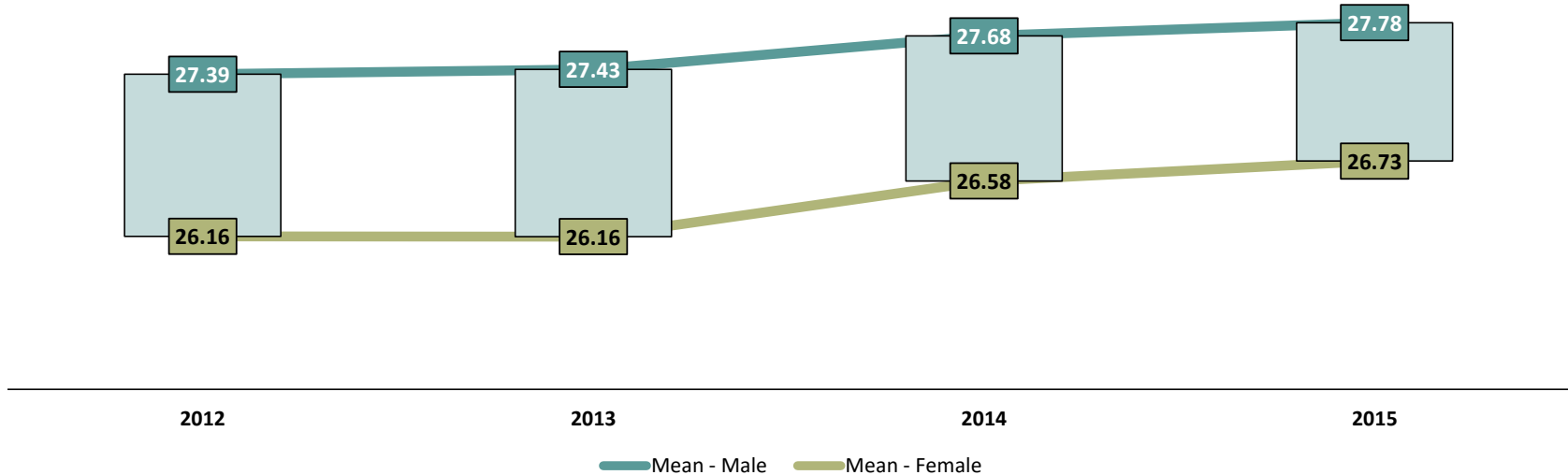

## Matriculants' Total MCAT Score - Mean

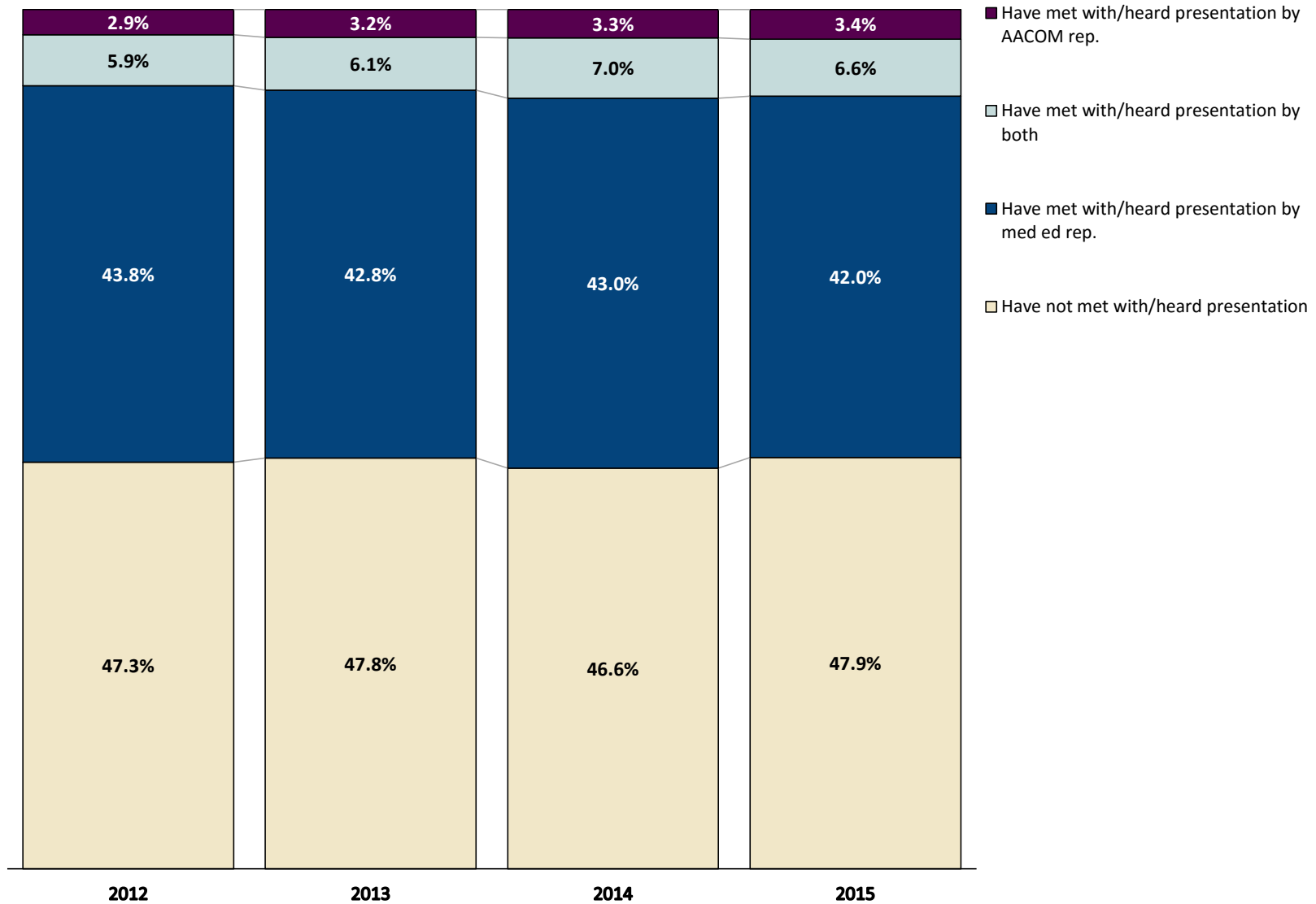


## Matriculants' MCAT Score by Gender - Mean



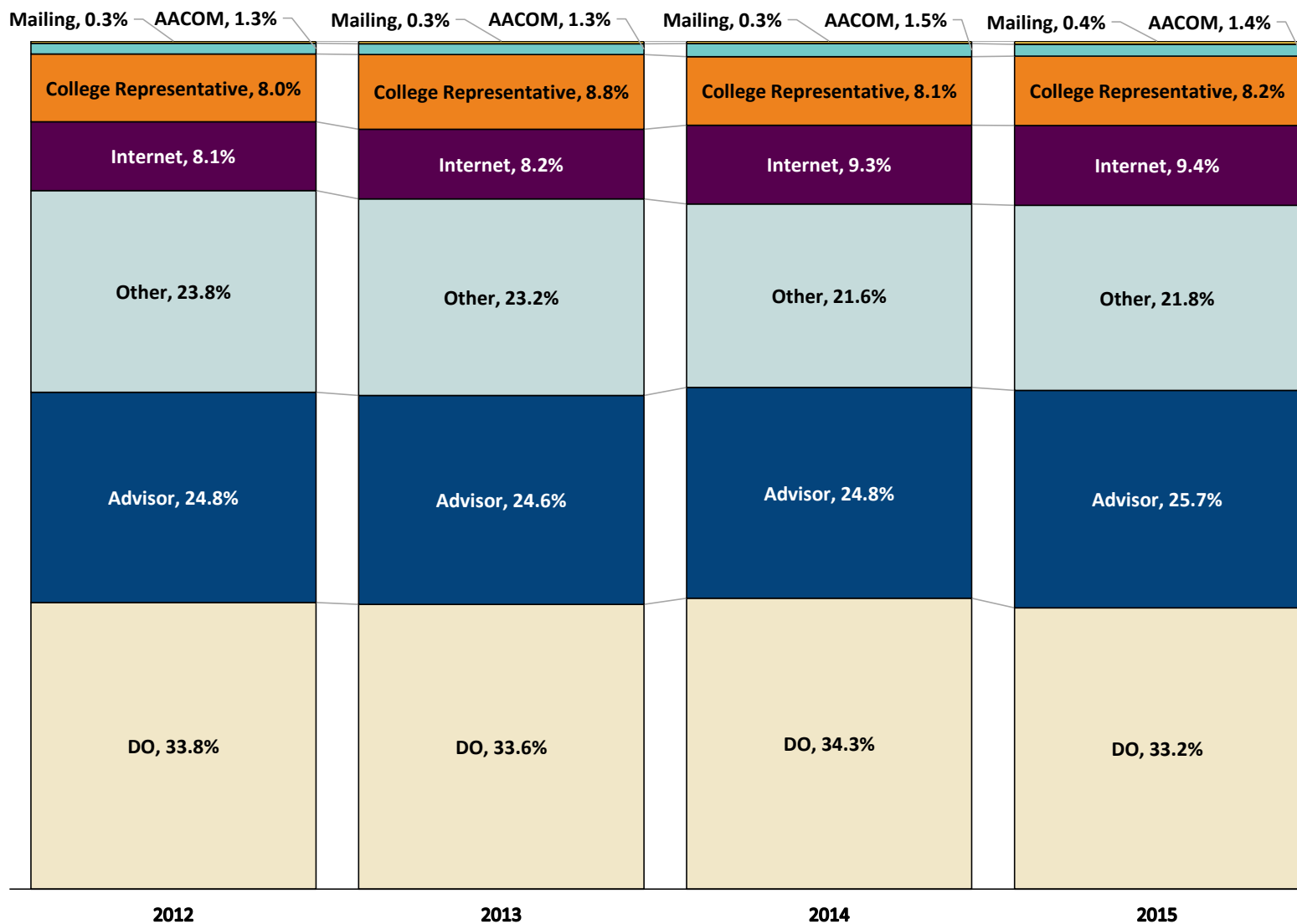

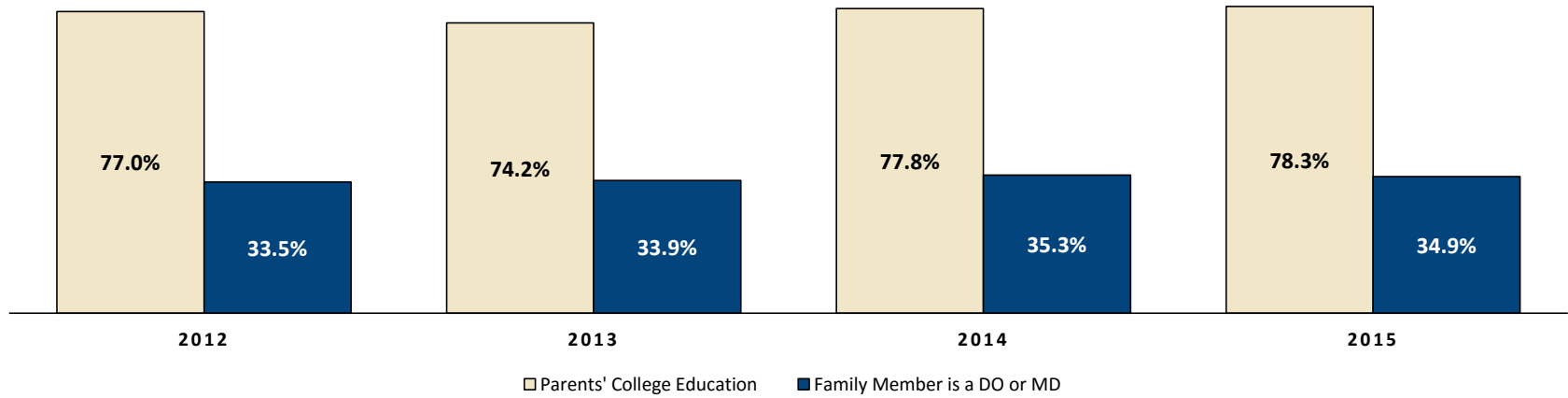
## How Matriculants First Learned About Osteopathic Medical Education - Percent



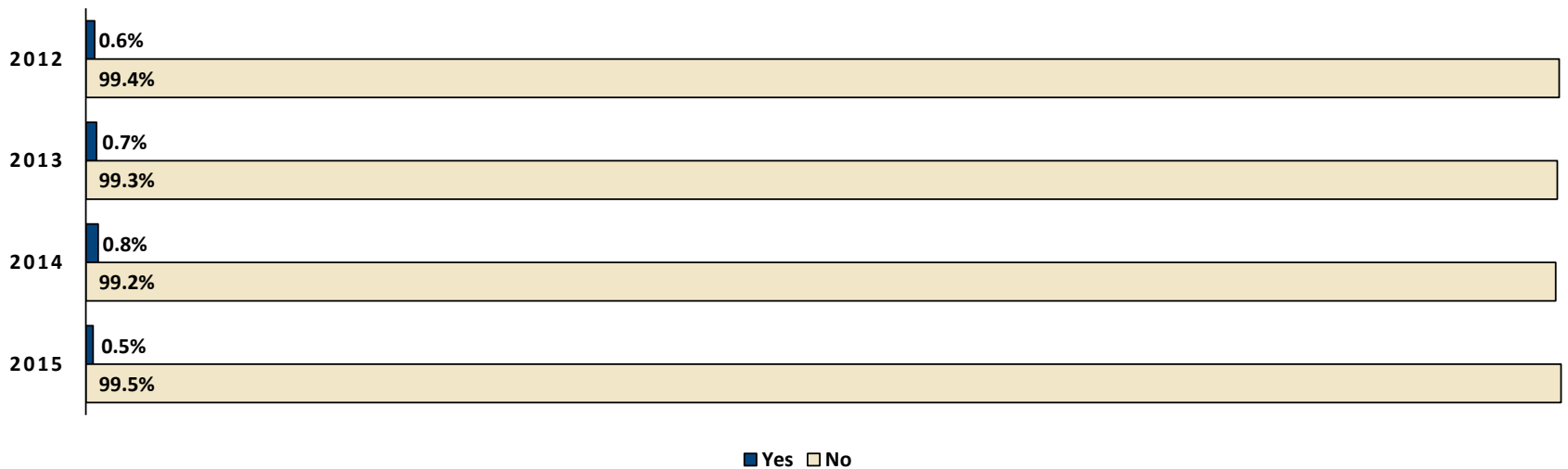
