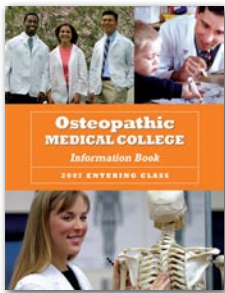


Acknowledgments

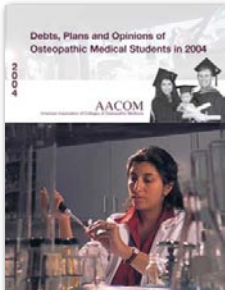
