The safety and wellbeing of our attendees and industry partners is a top priority for AACOM; therefore, we have implemented health and safety guidelines for Educating Leaders 2022. We ask in-person conference attendees to agree to the guidelines below when registering.

Educating Leaders 2022 Guidelines

COVID-19 VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-PERSON ATTENDANCE

Per CDC guidelines, attendees must be up to date on their COVID-19 vaccinations, including any booster dose(s). We invite and encourage those who are not vaccinated to join us virtually via the online platform. Both in-person and online attendees are eligible for CME credits. More information about CME is available on the registration page.

What should I do before I arrive? You will need to download our online screening app and upload your proof of vaccination. Further instructions are provided in the registration confirmation email and [here](#). Make sure to take a digital photograph of both sides of your personal vaccination record card and store it on your smartphone or bring a printed copy, as a back-up.

Bring a mask; a mask must be worn at all times while indoors when you are not eating or drinking. AACOM and the Sheraton Denver Downtown are following the CDC recommendations and – at this time – attendees will be required to wear masks indoors unless actively eating or drinking.

Acceptable masks must completely cover the nose and mouth and fit snugly under the chin and to the sides of the face. This includes KN95, N95 and other disposable surgical. Not acceptable are cloth masks, gaiters, bandannas, balaclavas, ski masks, the collars of shirts or sweaters, or masks that don't fit properly.

LIABILITY WAIVER

I understand that travel and gathering involves risk of sickness, including sickness from COVID-19.
