<ul> <li>Reread all emails from the program</li> <li>Confirm the correct date and time</li> <li>Confirm which virtual platform you will be using (Zoom, etc.) and run a test if possible</li> <li>Ensure the interview URL is ready to access</li> <li>Ensure your interview outfit is clean and ready</li> <li>Research the residency program and make notes of highlights/concerns</li> <li>Practice how you would answer common interview questions like the following:</li> <li>Biggest Strengths:</li> </ul>	The Night before the Interview  Reread your application and CV Reread the literature from the program, noting any specific instructions, etc. Check your planned webcam setup to ensure good background, lighting, camera level If using Zoom, double check the name and profile picture on your account Write down any questions you would like to ask the program:
<ul> <li>Biggest Weaknesses:</li> <li>Why this program:</li> <li>What did you do during quarantine:</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The Day of the Interview</li> <li>Make sure your virtual interview device is adequately charged AND plugged in</li> <li>Remind family/roommates, etc. that you will be interviewing and shouldn't be interrupted</li> <li>Final A/V check: <ul> <li>Webcam functional</li> <li>Lighting appropriate</li> <li>Headphones/headset sound levels (ambient mic not preferred)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Turn your cell phone OFF and put away (no sound, no vibrate, no temptation to look at it)</li> </ul>
