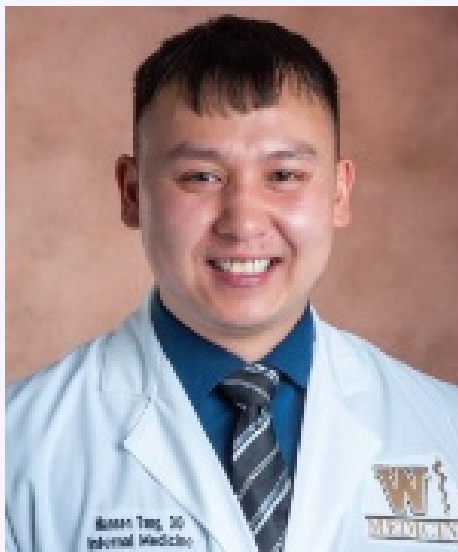
Expected graduation: 2027
