

2011-12 Osteopathic Medical College Total Enrollment, by College, by State of Legal Residence

The following three charts display the total enrollment of 30 osteopathic medical colleges (COM) and branch campuses by state of legal residence for school year 2011-12. Rows display state of legal residence; read down each column for COM enrollment by state. The importance of these data is twofold. We hope to pinpoint the states from which COMs attract their students and show how the COM student population is distributed across the states.

The report titled 2011-12 Osteopathic Medical College Total Enrollment, by College, by State of Legal Residence displays total enrollment of each COM, broken down by state of legal residence. Looking at the 'CO' row in the 'State' column and reading across, there are 8 students enrolled at ATSU-SOMA and 33 at AZCOM/MWU, both of which are located in Arizona. Alternatively, reading down the 'AZCOM/MWU' column shows total enrollment was 1 students from Alaska, 3 from Alabama and 1 from Arkansas.

The report 2011-12 Percent of Total Enrollment, by College, by State of Enrollment calculates total enrollment from each state as a percentage of total enrollment at each college. The columns total to 100%, but percentages of less than 2% enrollment in a college are not displayed for ease of viewing.

The report 2011-12 Percent of Total Enrollment, by College, by State of Legal Residence answers the question: Where did osteopathic medical students of a particular state attend school? It can best be understood by reading horizontally; for example, for students from Florida -- 26% went to LECOM Bradenton, 43% went to NSU-COM and others were distributed over other COMs. The rows total to 100%, but percentages of less than 2% are not displayed for ease of viewing.
