WHAT IS OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE?

Osteopathic medicine is a philosophy and practice of physician care in the United States, distinct in its whole-person approach and pioneering in its conceptualization of wellness.

Doctors of osteopathic medicine, or DOs, graduate from a college of osteopathic medicine and complete subsequent specialty training in residency programs and fellowships in hospitals, community health centers or other clinical settings. DOs work in primary care, medical specialty and research positions. DOs are also trained in Osteopathic Manipulative Medicine (OMM), the science of using one's hands to diagnose and treat ailments.

Osteopathic medicine is one of the fastest growing segments of healthcare.

KEY DATES



The AACOMAS cycle opens annually on the first Monday in May and closes on the second Friday in April. Application deadlines vary by college of osteopathic medicine.



Advisors can access decision and matriculation data for the previous cycle annually on January 15 in UAP.
