Transforming residency training: The AMA's new \$15-million grant program

The American Medical Association's new "**Reimagining Residency**" initiative will address challenges associated with the transition from undergraduate medical education (UME) to graduate medical education (GME) and the maintenance of progressive development during residency and across the continuum of physician training.

The goal of the five-year, \$15-million grant program is to transform residency training to better address the workforce needs of our current and future health care system. The grants will support innovations that provide a meaningful and safe transition from UME to GME, establish new curricular content and experiences to enhance readiness for practice and promote well-being in training.

The AMA "Reimagining Residency" initiative builds on the work of the AMA "Accelerating Change in Medical Education" effort, which has reinvented the way undergraduate medical students are taught and trained. To date, the consortium of 32 medical schools has impacted more than 19,000 medical students who will one day provide care for more than 33 million patients annually.

GME funding opportunity

In early January 2019 the AMA will post a request for proposals (RFP) for its "Reimagining Residency" initiative. Applicants will be solicited in the form of partnerships among U.S. GME sponsors, medical schools, health systems and specialty societies. These partnerships will be funded to support bold and innovative projects that promote systemic change in graduate medical education.

Important grant dates

Interested parties will be required to submit a Letter of Intent describing the goals and scope of their proposed project. Please make note of these important dates and activities.

April 17, 2019	Full proposals due
June 2019	Announcement of awards
