What is the Single Accreditation System?



Creates a unified graduate medical education system – the essential phase of the formation of specialist physicians in the United States.

Began in February 2014.

Scheduled to be completed in July 2020.

Impact on Education Structure





GME Accreditation

The agreement streamlines the accreditation of GME programs but preserves and protects the structures across the educational continuum within each medical profession.

AOA Residency Program Transition Status



- 47% of all 1,244 programs ACGME accredited or preaccredited as of January 1, 2017
 - 64% of 861 residencies
 - 10% of 262 fellowships
 - 12% of 121 internships
- 80% of all 4+ Year programs accredited or pre-accredited
 - These programs eligible for 2017 Match
 - Remaining programs voluntarily not participating in the Match or closed
- 48 programs have achieved Osteopathic Recognition
 - Programs must achieve initial accreditation before they can be evaluated for OR

2017 AOA Match



- 3,338 positions listed in the 2017 AOA Match at this time, compared to 3,229 this time last year.
- 23 AOA programs have already transitioned to the ACGME and are recruiting in the NRMP match. These programs represent 65 training positions.
- AOA Standard X: Programs 4 years or more in length that did not apply by Jan. 1, 2017, will not be available to add to Rank Order Lists in the AOA Match.

- Eligibility FAQs for specialties that require a <u>preliminary</u> year
- Eligibility for board certification is under the authority of individual boards, not the ACGME
